Why play chess?

Chess is fun! Once mastered can be played with family and friends of all ages and nationalities.

- Chess is a fantastic tool for developing character at a young age such as resilience, patience, sportsmanship.
- Understand that decisions have consequences, “growth mind-set” – learns from setbacks.
- Chess encourages creative thinking, pattern recognition.

In the club children will have fun learning with children of similar age. During the club the children are taught various tactics, opening and endgames. They will solve chess puzzles in a tutored, interactive class setting.

**There will be a tournament during the term with prizes for all including a winner's trophy and medals for runners-up.** *In order to improve your child's chess skills, I would recommend they try to play three games of chess a week.*

Chess club is for learners. Children should know how each piece moves and captures before joining the club.

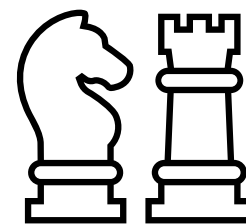
