On Monday, I attended St George's Cathedral with Year 6 for their Leavers' Mass, with other Catholic primary and Secondary schools in Merton and Sutton in attendance.

On Tuesday morning, year 6 SATS results were announced. The children in Year 6 complete these statutory tests alongside other state schools nationally and they are one small part of the important year. We are incredibly proud of our year 6 children, who have been well prepared and approached these tests with positivity and calmness. The results are a testament to Mr Connell, the year 6 staff and the pupils who have worked so well together. Sacred Heart children have achieved strong results in reading, writing and mathematics and we are very proud of them all. Children in Year 6 nationally achieving the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Mathematics is 62%, at Sacred Heart 81% of our pupils achieved the expected standard or higher in all three of these areas. This week St Kateri finished their RSE journey, looking at how they grow in a holistic way with God.



