School Improvement Fund

We recently asked parents to contribute to our Governors' Maintenance Fund. We realise that this name may have caused some confusion. To make this clearer, we will refer to it as the School Improvement Fund.

This fund supports projects that improve our school buildings and grounds, helping us maintain a safe, warm, and welcoming environment for all children. As a Voluntary Aided School, Sacred Heart receives government funding for day-to-day education costs. However, because our school building is owned by the Diocese, the school community is asked to contribute towards major building and site works. Across all faith schools in the UK, parents are asked to contribute 10% towards these costs. This contribution is voluntary.

The School Improvement Fund works in the same way as contributions for school trips: while voluntary, we can only go ahead if enough money is collected. If we do not receive sufficient contributions, we will be unable to accept the grant that funds the building work. Details on how to contribute to the fund are:
