## World Book Day

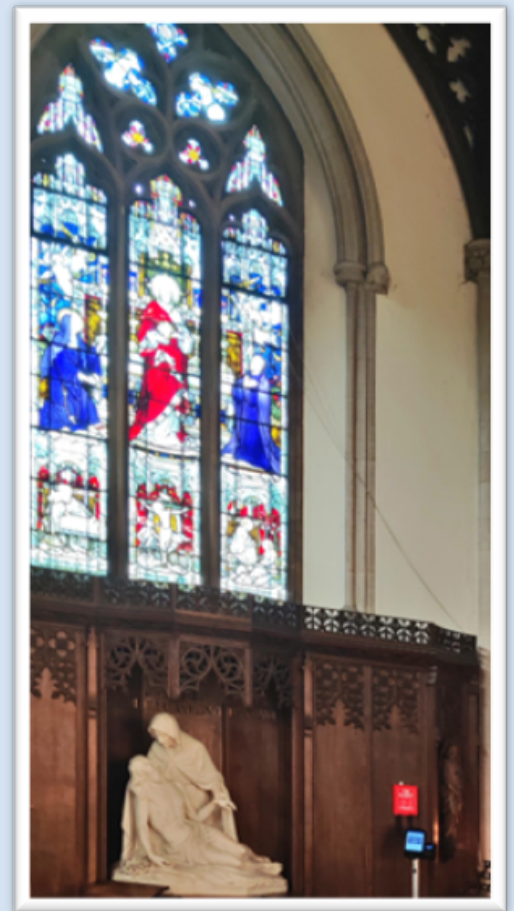
