All juniors can attend the London Broncos Rugby League for FREE this Sunday as part of their Easter Extravaganza.

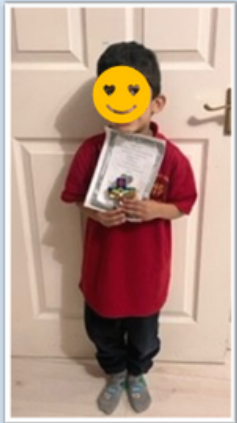
The match is against Batley Bulldogs at Cherry Red Records Stadium in Wimbledon at 3pm.

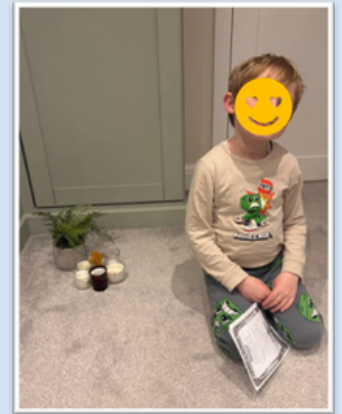
Lent at Sacred Heart

Reconciliation and Forgiveness

Our Prayer Leaders thoughtfully planned and led a special Reconciliation Service focused on the theme of forgiveness. Through their retelling of The Parable of the Prodigal Son, they helped pupils reflect on how we can sometimes distance ourselves from God, yet are always lovingly welcomed back when we say sorry. Pupils across Key Stage 2 were also given the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation with Fr Peter, who visits us each Wednesday.

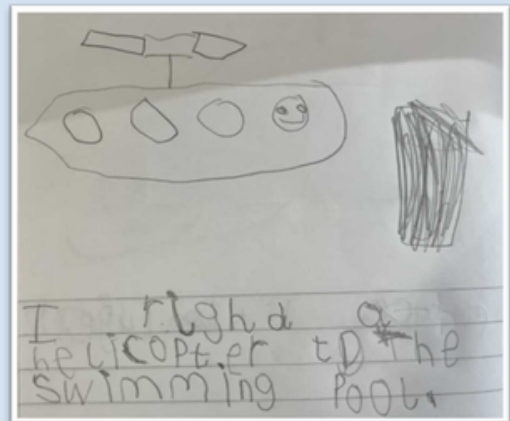
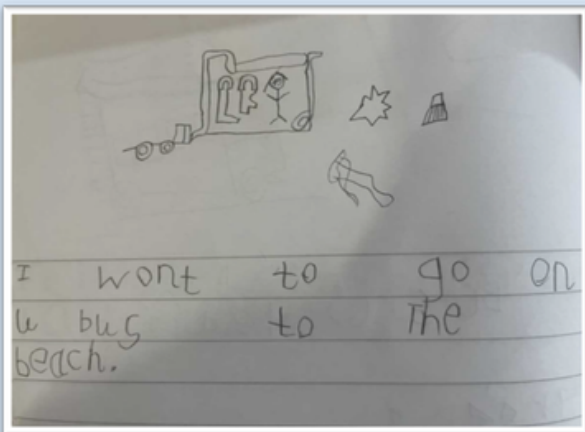
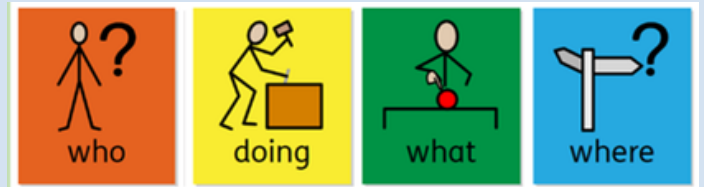


This Week in St Bernadette Class
