It is the time of year when teachers are preparing information for end of year reports, including assessment information. Year 6 have already completed their SATs. This week, Year 4 have been completing their multiplication tables checks, and Year 1 will begin their phonics screening next week. Children in Years 1 to 5 will also complete assessments in maths and reading over the next few weeks. These help teachers to see what children have understood and remembered from their learning in class, and to identify any areas where they may need further support. The assessments are intended to be low stress, familiar classroom activities. If parents have any questions, please speak to your child's teacher in the first instance.

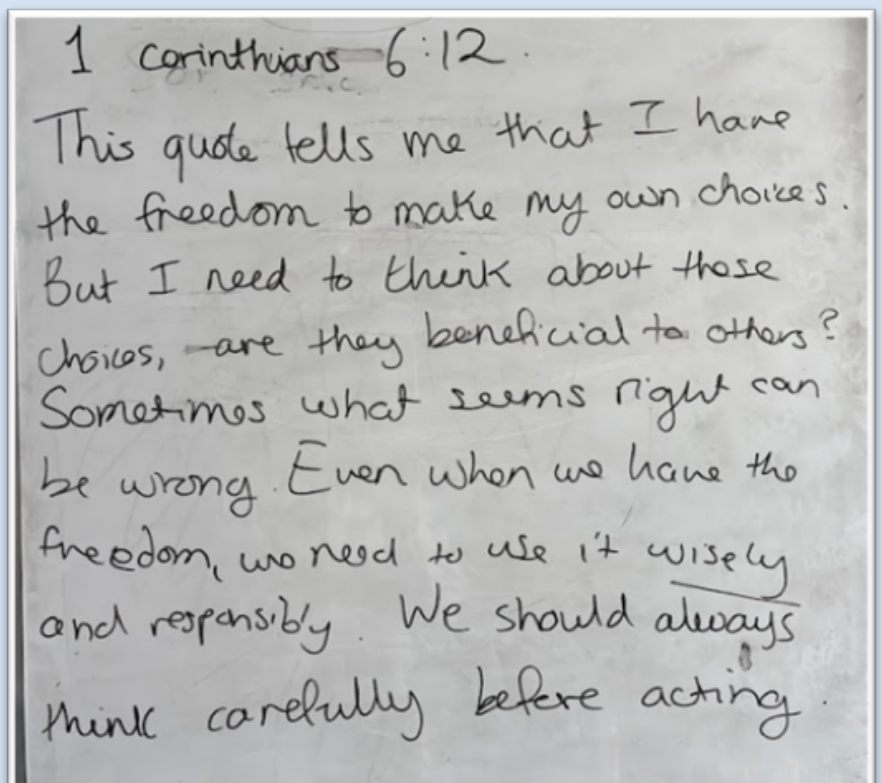
This Week in St Kateri Class
