Merton Playgrounds Upgrades

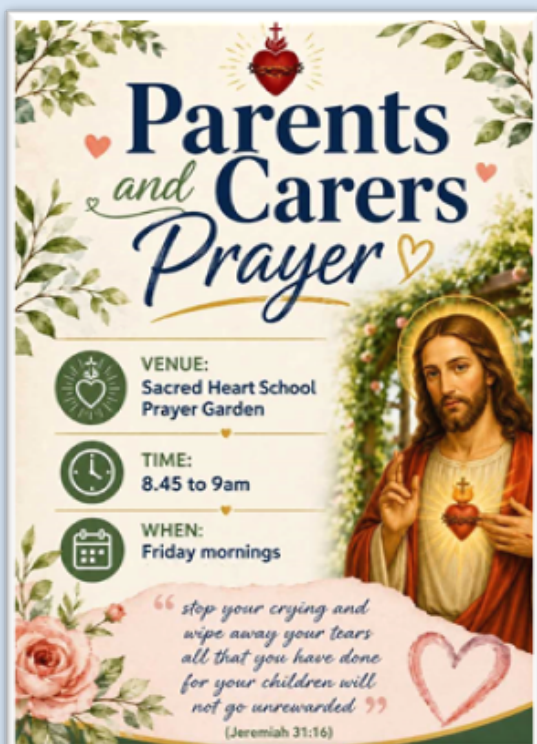

This Week in St Clare Class

This week in St Clare we have been making exciting links across our learning through our desert topic. In Science, we investigated shadows and explored how they are formed.

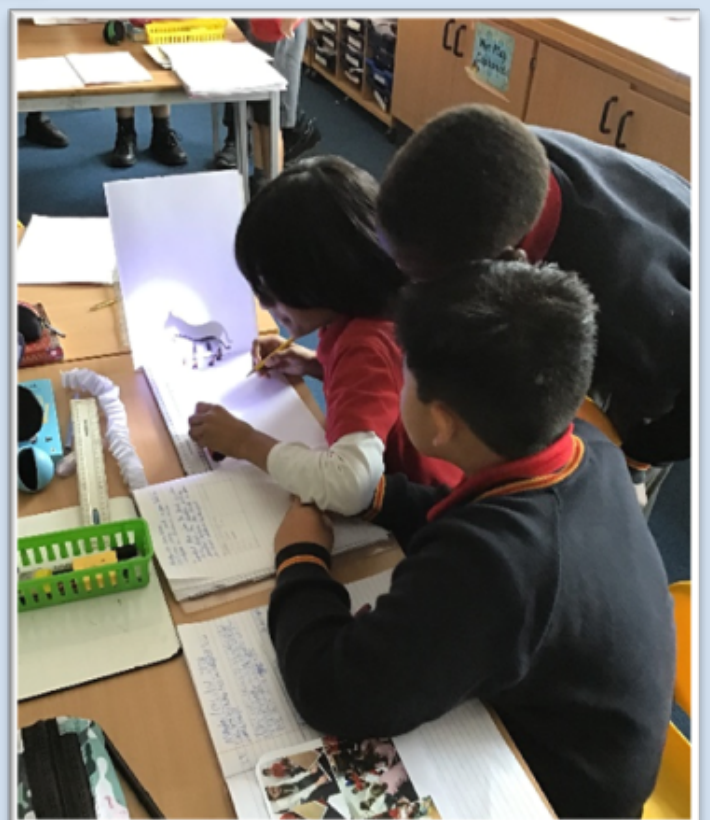
Through practical investigations, we observed how the size and shape of shadows can change depending on the position of the light source.



This then linked to our learning across the curriculum. In Art, we have been using oil pastels to create vibrant desert landscapes, carefully blending colours to capture the temperature and light of the desert environment.

In Geography, we have been learning about how deserts are formed and exploring their unique physical features, while in English we have been writing survival tips, considering the challenges someone may face when surviving in such an unforgiving climate.
