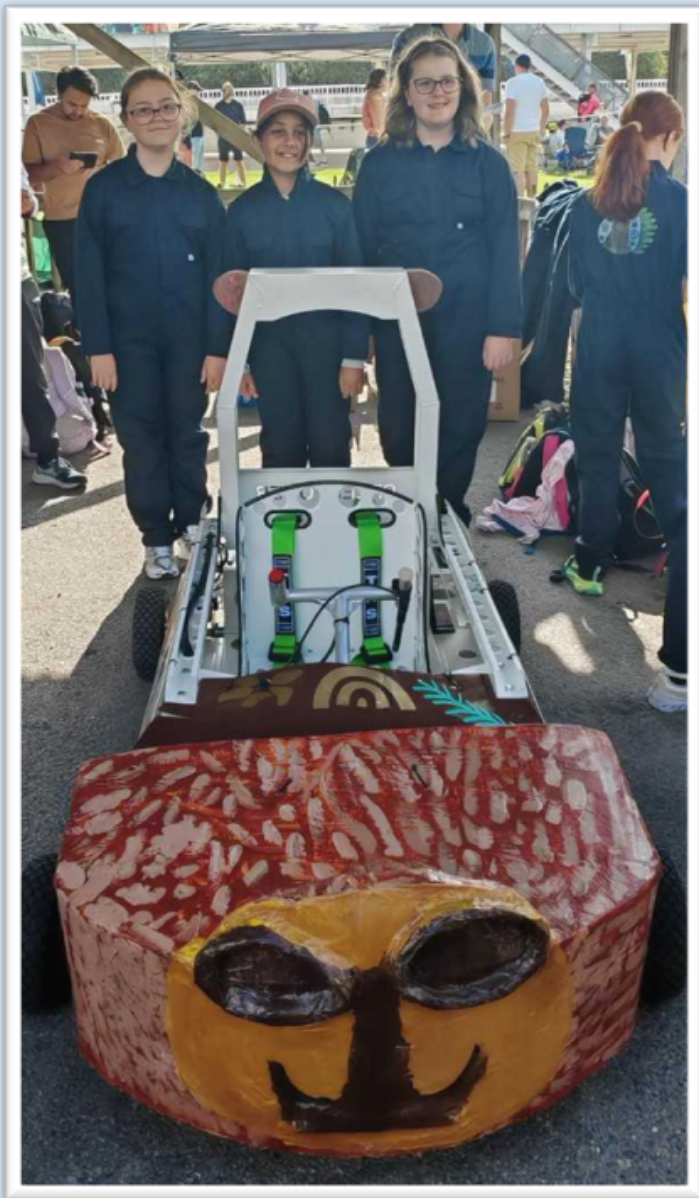


Lastly, in Maths, we have been recapping our learning about halves and quarters.
