Break The Rules Day

The School Council are having a 'break the rules' day Monday 13th July. There are 5 specific rules that the children can choose to break that day. The catch is that they have to pay 50p for each rule they wish to break. The rules are:

1. Wearing own clothes
2. Having juice or squash in your water bottle
3. Bringing an unhealthy snack
4. Free choice of seating in class for one lesson
5. Bring a fidget / small cuddly toy to school

All other school rules will remain in place and will need to be adhered to! Money raised from this day will go to the School Council to enable them to buy equipment to play with at break and lunchtimes. Children need to bring in cash for the rules they are choosing to break from the list above.

Smartphone Free Childhood

A reminder to all parents that, from September, Sacred Heart will be smartphone free for children.

If your child will be in Year 6 from September 2026 and walks to or from school independently, they may bring a simple 'brick' style mobile phone to school. Smartphones and smart watches will not be permitted in school.

Any brick phones brought into school must be handed to the class teacher at the beginning of the day and collected at the end of the day.

This approach is in line with the updated statutory guidance for schools, which states that schools should be mobile phone free environments during the school day. Thank you for your support in helping us keep children safe and focused on their learning.

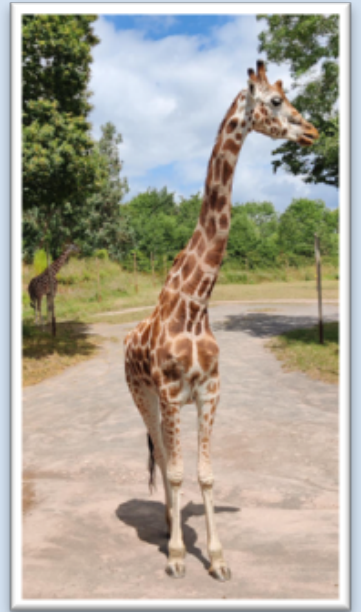
Year 5 are holding a cake sale on Monday 13th July after school.
